2018 ANNUAL REPORT

Welcome to this Annual Report and annual newsletter for the past financial year 2017/18.

We have all been busy with the new committee of 3MBR FM, comprising of John Ramke as Chairperson, Max Wurfel as Secretary, Tyronne Richardson, John Heintze, Christine Heintze Peter Hooper and Paul Kinnaird. The previous chairman John Heintze has taken a back seat after many years at the helm as he has many other commitments and has taken a principal role as Transition consultant. Peter Hooper has acted as volunteer Engineering Manager and as Operations Manager with the assistance of David Quinn.
